Over the last few months we have practised and practised all of the songs ready for the final performance. Thousands of parents came to watch. We have never performed to such a big audience before, it was fantastic.



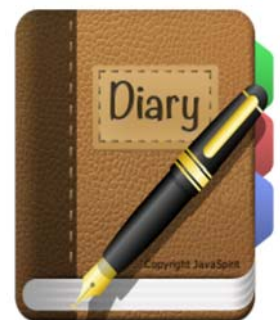
