How to make a Cheerio Bird Feeder

Cheerios
Pipe cleaners



1. Make a loop in the end of the pipe cleaner to keep the Cheerios from falling off.
2. String the Cheerios onto the pipe cleaner, leaving about 2 inches at the end (this should be about 40 Cheerios).
3. Twist the two ends together, leaving a loop to hang it from.
4. Bend and twist it into any shape you like.
