Personal, Social, and Emotional Development

We will be using our growing confidence to support our integrations with key stage 1 and starting swimming lessons.

Communication and Language

We will be using our listening skills to pay attention to others and respond appropriately to what they are saying or doing.

Physical Development

This term we will be swimming every Monday. This will not only challenge our confidence and gross motor skills but also our ability to get manage our time getting changed.

Literacy

We will be working hard on mark making for a purpose and to support our role play and understanding of signs. We will also be reading a range of books to support our learning of different occupations.

Maths

In maths we will be counting reliably with numbers from 1 to 20, placing them in order and saying which number is one more or one less than a given number. We will also be using everyday language to talk about size, weight, capacity, position, distance, time and money to compare quantities and objects and to solve problems.

Understanding the World

We are going to be thinking about the variety of people who help us and the importance of keeping ourselves safe and healthy. This half term we will look closely at firefighters, police officers, doctors, nurses, paramedics and vets.

Expressive Art & Design

As part of our new topic we will be developing our imagination skills to act out different professions of people who help us.
